The Vermont Department of Public Service, on behalf of the State of Vermont, moves for

a stay in this proceeding while the Commission considers a Petition for Reconsideration related

to the Commission's approval of certain exemptions from emergency planning requirements at

the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station.<sup>1</sup> Because Vermont's attorney did not certify that

he "made a sincere effort to contact other parties in the proceeding and [to] resolve the issue(s)

raised in the motion," as required by 10 C.F.R. § 2.323(b), the motion is denied. Vermont may

refile its motion after making the required consultations.

It is so ORDERED.
