ORDER RE: EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PREFILED TESTIMONY

On May 6, 2015, the Vermont Public Service Board ("Board") issued an Order establishing a schedule for this proceeding. Pursuant to that Order, the deadline for parties other than Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (collectively, "Entergy VY") to file prefiled testimony was August 19, 2015.

On August 19, 2015, the New England Coalition, Inc. ("NEC") filed a letter requesting an extension until August 21, 2015, to file its prefiled testimony. In its letter, NEC proposes that the deadline for Entergy VY to file its initial round of discovery questions on NEC also be extended two days, to September 4, 2015, and that the schedule otherwise remain unchanged. NEC represents that Entergy VY has no objection to its request.

Windham Regional Commission confirmed via e-mail on August 19, 2015, that it had no objection to NEC's request. No other parties have commented on NEC's request for an extension.

In the absence of any objection to NEC's proposal, we grant NEC's request and the schedule for this proceeding is hereby modified accordingly.
