**JOINT MOTION FOR STATUS CONFERENCE**

The Vermont Department of Public Service (“DPS”), the Agency of Natural Resources (“ANR”), and the Attorney General’s Office (“AGO”) (collectively, the “State Parties”), together with NorthStar Decommissioning Holdings, LLC, NorthStar Nuclear Decommissioning Company, LLC, NorthStar Group Services, Inc., LVI Parent Corporation, NorthStar Group Holdings, LLC (collectively, “NorthStar”), Entergy Nuclear Vermont Investment Company, LLC, and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (collectively, “Entergy,” and together with NorthStar, the “Joint Petitioners”), and the New England Coalition on Nuclear Pollution, Inc., Windham Regional Commission, Conservation Law Foundation, Elnu Abenaki Tribe, and Town of Vernon Planning and Economic Development Committee (together with the State Parties and Joint Petitioners, the “Parties”), hereby move the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) to set a status conference in the above-captioned docket for February 23, 2018, in lieu of the February 21, 2018, date previously proposed in the “Joint Status Update,” filed February 9, 2018.

Pursuant to the “Procedural Order Re: Postponement of Status Conference” entered by the Commission on February 2, 2018, the Parties, joined by the Abenaki Nation of Missisquoi, submitted a joint status update in which they requested that the Commission set a status conference for February 21, 2018. In light of the status of ongoing negotiations, the Parties now believe that they will be in a better position to provide a meaningful update to the Commission and propose a schedule to govern the remainder of the proceedings in this docket if the Commission instead sets a status conference for February 23, 2018. The Parties would submit a proposed schedule by noon on the business day prior to the conference, or at such other time as the Commission may order.
